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Child Observation Time Sample

time samples are repeated short focused snapshots of child development used to collect precise data. time samples can be used to observe a child's behaviour to identify possible concerns. For example a shy child who does not relate to other children. The observer needs to be aware of not making it obvious to the child that they are being observed.

Laura - Time Sample Conclusion The observation revealed a girl who doesn't speak to children or adults and seems rather isolated. The time sample observation is inconclusive about whether Laura does speak at all. Clearly it is possible that she did speak and/or socialised more outside the time sample periods.

In this tape you are shown two types of observation: time sampling and event sampling. Time sampling Time sampling is often used where there is a concern about an aspect of behaviour. It involves observing a child for an extended period such as a whole morning/afternoon session, or even a whole day.

Observation of Child's Emotional Development

A tally is kept to record the specific time or a length of time the behaviour occurred. Time samples are effective in reducing a child's negative behaviour by understanding why and when a particular is occurring during the day. Time samples can be taken every half an hour over a day or for shorter intervals of five to ten minutes. Example:

The observations are only brief but will include the activity the child is engaged in, which area of the nursery they are in and the level of involvement at that particular time.

Time sampling: Use to get a general picture of a child's activities. The child is observed in time intervals over a period of time, For example every 30 mins over a 3 hour period. You must decide the time intervals before you begin observing.
